Dear Parents,

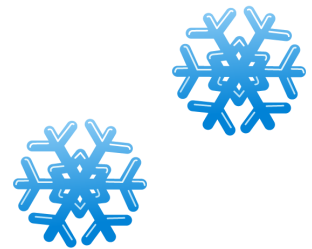
Happy New Year! It was so nice to see all of the children at school. I hope everyone had a wonderful Christmas Break. We are looking forward to the second semester!
